Regulations on the selection process for the bachelor's degree programme in Social Sciences (restricted admission)

Section 1 Selection Process

(1) After the advance quotas (cases with priority, cases of hardship, international students, additional degree) have been subtracted, 80% of the remaining places in the bachelor's degree programme in Social Sciences are allocated according to the result of a selection process and the other 20% according to the applicants' waiting period.

(2) Selection is to occur according to a process mark which results from the average mark of the university entrance qualification combined with the marks (points) in three subjects in the university entrance qualification.

(3) The process mark is determined by

- average mark = 51%
- politics/civics/social studies or history = 24%
- German = 15%
- English = 10%

Section 2 Entry into Force

These regulations shall enter into force subsequent to publication in the official bulletin of Leibniz University Hannover.
