Description of activities	This placement is suited to students who would like experience assisting in the teaching of Drama and English.  You would also play a major part in the Direction and Production of the school musical which we start preparing for in January, culminating in April with the performance.  You would work alongside and support our Drama and English teacher by helping with the planning and developing of activities and making/adapting resources according to students abilities and learning styles.  Intercultural strategies are used to promote a positive learning environment and encourage the pupil's international mindedness and you would be expected to demonstrate an understanding, patient, warm, and receptive attitude towards the pupils and show interest in their progress.	



	You will be assigned a Mentor who will be responsible for your professional development throughout your placement.  You would help out a maximum of 30 hours per week from Monday to Friday and one Saturday Open morning per term.
