To work alongside and support our bilingual teachers by helping with the planning of activities, conversation and role plays, enabling our students to improve their French and English. To take small conversation groups to allow students to carry out skills-based-activities and encourage communication in French and English. To help with the supervision of students in their break times and extra curricular-activities.
