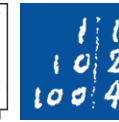

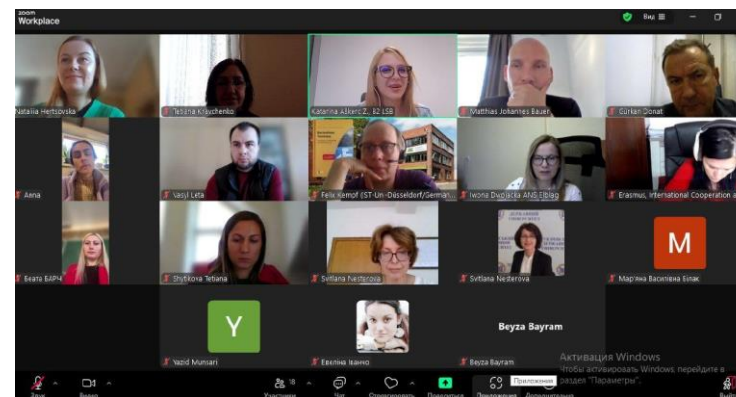

Best Practices of project implementation

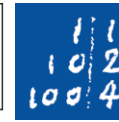
- Close interaction with the university and faculty management, foreign partners and project participants
- Social impact: reaching the level of the local community and regional institutions
- Empowering partnerships through different kinds of networking
- Successful examples of new forms of partnership (student mobility etc.)
- Implementation of Internationalization Strategy aspects
- Follow-up: initiating a new project through the synergy of the already existing partnerships and new ideas derived from Mol Ukraine 2024 program

Challenges of project implementation

- Making Project's goals measurable, assignable and time-related
- Categorising stakeholders involved as well as their areas of responsibility within the Power Interest Grid
- Categorising the activities, measures and events already implemented or being implemented at a university
- Adjusting the workload of the academic and administrative staff involved in the implementation of the Project
- Improving hard and soft skills (time management and communication)

Lessons learnt and Recommendations

- Project's goals must be specific, assignable and time-related
- Project is supposed to have measurable deliverables (tangible results)
- Project is expected to be sustainable and roadmapped for further development
- Project should be enlisted for feasible challenges/risks and their possible solutions
- Partnership should be as much multi-level as possible - educational, research, social
- Networking should be multifaceted (national and international)
