Bachelor's programmes

Only very few undergraduate study programmes require German applicants to provide a language certificate:

English Studies as subject in the Interdisciplinary Bachelor's Degree Programme or the Bachelor's Teacher Training Course for Technical Education	English Level B2 (CEFR), own language regulations by the English department
Spanish as subject in the Interdisciplinary Bachelor's Degree Programme or the Bachelor's Teacher Training Course for Technical Education	Spanish level B1; own language regulations of the Department of Romance Languages and Literatures

Master's programmes

Some postgraduate degree programmes also require German applicants to provide a language certificate:

Advanced Anglophone Studies	English Level C1 (CEFR), own language regulations by the English department
Atlantic Studies in History, Culture and Society	English B2 AND another subject-related foreign language B1 (preferably French and/or Spanish)
Energy Technology	English B2
European Legal Practice LL.M Joint Degree	B2- Knowledge in a language of instruction of the partner universities, whereby the first language for the main university has to be either German, French or Portuguese and the language for the secondary University must be either German, French, Portuguese or English.
European Master in Landscape Architecture (EMiLA)	English B2 Applicants wishing to study in Versailles and / or Barcelona must

	have at least A2 proficiency level in French and / or Spanish at the time of application. Until the beginning of studies in the respective country, the required language level B1 (French) or B2 (Spanish) must be proven.
European Master in Territorial Development	English B2
German and English Linguistics	English B2
History	Two foreign languages B1
International Horticulture	English B2 (for the English Language Majors Plant Production and Propagation, Plant Biotechnology, Physiology and Genetics, and Economics)
International Mechatronics	English B2
Modern German Literature	At least one foreign language B1
Philosophy of Science	English B2
Water Resources and Environmental Management	English C1
