CALL FOR APPLICATIONS:

STIPENDIUM FOR LONG-TERM STAYS OF EARLY CAREER RESEARCHERS IN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE EUROPEAN UNIVERSITIES Linking Society and Technology (EULiST)

Leibniz University Hannover is part of the European university alliance "EULiST - European Universities Linking Society and Technology". The alliance focuses on sustainability, excellence, openness, diversity and inclusion and makes research and teaching in Europe tangible for early career researchers. Early Career Researchers can apply for a mobility grant within the framework of EULiST-CONNECT in order to realise a long-term stay (up to 3 months) at one of our partner universities.

European University Alliances are recognised as universities of the future and drivers of development in society. Take the opportunity to participate in our European University Alliance and network with our EULiST partner universities.

WHO can be funded:

- Doctoral students and post-docs at LUH who wish to go to an EULiST partner university as part of a long-term mobility programme.

WHAT can be funded:

- Participation in summer and winter schools at EULiST partner universities.
- Stays for research and study purposes at EULiST partner universities.

DAUER der Mobilität:

- Up to 3 months

What expended can be funded:

- Travel and accomodation expenses: Travel stipend in the amount of 325€; Accomodation stipend in the amount of 1.350€/mo.

Process:

1. Complete the EULiST-CONNECT application form.
2. Attach the following documents and submit to eulist@zuv.uni-hannover.de :
 - a. Invitation from the partner university (e.g. a faculty member).
 - b. Signed data protection declaration.
3. After the application has been reviewed by the local coordinators at LUH, you will receive feedback within 14 days. Central selection criteria are a) motivation, b) goal(s) of the mobility and c) availability of funds.
4. If your application is funded, we will issue a funding agreement.
5. At the end of your stay, we require a signed Confirmation of Stay and a short report on your experience within 14 days.

Note:

- Applications can be submitted at any time up to at least 6 weeks before the start of travel.
