



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS:

SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENT SHORT-TERM-STAYS WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE EUROPEAN UNIVERSITY ALLIANCE EULIST (*European Universities Linking Society and Technology*)

Leibniz University Hannover is part of the European university alliance "EULiST - European Universities Linking Society and Technology". The alliance focuses on sustainability, excellence, openness, diversity and inclusion and makes it possible for students to experience research and teaching in Europe. As part of EULiST-CONNECT, students can apply for a mobility grant for short stays at one of our partner universities.

European university alliances are seen as the universities of the future and drivers of development in society. Take the opportunity to participate in our European University Alliance and network with our EULIST partner universities!

LUH's EULiST partner universities are

WHO can be funded:

• Outgoings: Students (Bachelor, Master) who are enrolled at LUH and want to go to a EULiST partner university as part of a short-term mobility.

WHAT can be funded:

- Participation in EULiST Student Board meetings, EULiST conferences, EULiST events and European networking events.
- Participation in summer schools at EULiST partner universities.
- Stays at EULiST partner-universities for research and study purposes.
- Meetings in connection with joint work on EULiST activities (e.g. as part of the work packages).

WHAT cannot be funded:

- Participation in Blended Intensive Programs (BIPs) is excluded from the application. BIPs can be funded through Erasmus+.
- Semester stays cannot be funded through the EULIST CONNECT program. However they can be funded through the ERASMUS program.

DURATION of the mobility:

• 1 day -14 days.

Which costs can be funded?

 Outgoings: Travel and accommodation costs: Travel stipend according to the destination country as per the PROMOS funding rates (see <u>partial scholarship mobility in euros</u>); accommodation allowance of 45€/day.

Procedure:

- 1. Apply using the online EULiST-CONNECT application form (Register for this in the application portal MoveOn).
- 2. Upload the following attachments:
 - a. Invitation from the partner university (e.g. faculty member or member of the student council).
 - b. Short letter of motivation in which the aim of the mobility is presented and justified.
 - c. A valid certificate of enrollment.
 - d. Signed data protection declaration through MoveOn.
- 3. after the application has been reviewed by the EULiST Local Coordination, you will receive feedback within 14 days. Key selection criteria are a) motivation and goal of the mobility and b) availability of funds.
- 4. after the end of the mobility, we require a signed Confirmation of Stay within 14 days and a short written report about your stay.

Please note:

• Applications can be submitted at any time, up to at least 6 weeks before the start of the trip.
