## Regulations on the selection process for the bachelor's degree programme in Social Sciences (restricted admission)

## Section 1 Selection Process

- (1) After the advance quotas (cases with priority, cases of hardship, international students, additional degree) have been subtracted, 80% of the remaining places in the bachelor's degree programme in Social Sciences are allocated according to the result of a selection process and the other 20% according to the applicants' waiting period.
- (2) Selection is to occur according to a process mark which results from the average mark of the university entrance qualification combined with the marks (points) in three subjects in the university entrance qualification.
- (3) The process mark is determined by
- average mark = 51%
- politics/civics/social studies or history = 24%
- German = 15%
- English = 10%

## Section 2 Entry into Force

These regulations shall enter into force subsequent to publication in the official bulletin of Leibniz University Hannover.
